

Dear Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,

Recently during a worship service, I read a snippet about prayer from a book I'm currently reading. Several of you mentioned that you appreciated it and so I am sharing it here in an abridged version. If you find it helpful, perhaps you might want to keep this somewhere as a reminder.

“Everybody seems to talk about (prayer). Every religious person believes in it, and many of the nonreligious ones. Prayer is a big deal. It changes the world. There's power in prayer.

It's also a big guilt trip for me, because I'm terrible at it. It's embarrassing. I'm in my forties. I always thought that I'd be good at this by now.

At risk of further humiliating myself, here's my usual mental monologue during group prayer, when we close our eyes and people take turns jumping in with prayer.

Ok, focus on what this guy is saying. Yes, Lord, help his grandma who is sick with cancer... I kinda miss my grandma. She used to have Cocoa Krispies for us. Mom never let us have that, but grandma did.

And, Lord, please help the lady who's praying right now... Lord, I feel so bad I don't know that ladies name. Sharla? Sharleen? Something like that. My sister-in-law is named Sharla. I wonder how she is doing.

It's silent now. What's going on? Are they waiting for me? Quick: Who do I know that is in the hospital?.... I guess I'll clear my throat and start and – Okay. Steve started.

Cool. God, we thank you for whatever Steve is talking about, and oh wow I guess we're wrapping it up in Jesusnameamen.

Prayer time finished. Someone says something about how powerful it was and how they could sense God's presence. I again wonder why God doesn't give up on me and my fluttering, faithless mind. Here's where it's helpful for me to remember something.

(Jesus) stood in front of a crowd and told them how to pray in Matthew 6... and then he prays for about twenty-five seconds. And then he quits!

So, God Himself told us how to pray, and it's incredibly short. This strikes me as more than just instructive, more than just corrective, and more than ironic. For people like me and maybe you, if you're terrible at prayer, it's just beautiful. And merciful. And understanding. Even tender.

It's like God already knows about our fluttering little minds. He knows we're like little birds, easily distracted little things, and the weak among us still really do want to be part of His kingdom.

Twenty-five seconds. As it turns out, that's about all I have before my mind starts to drift. Embarrassing? Yes. But I'm not alone. I want you to know, if you're like me, that God understands and still wants us at the party. Jesus said 'Pray like this' – and He kept it short.

This is a God who knows us and loves us, indeed.”¹

Take Ridge Road (104 expressway) to Hard Road in Webster. Turn right after exiting and continue across Ridge Rd. Hard Rd. becomes Shoecraft Rd. At the stop sign turn left on to State Rd. Maryvew Dr. is on the left with a white picket fence and a sign Villas at East Hampton. The clubhouse is on the left (111 Maryview) next to the swimming pool. Park in the lot or on the street.

Take 590 to Empire Blvd. Turn right after exiting. Take Empire to Plank Rd. (right turn). Take Plank Rd. to State Rd. (left turn at the fire station). - ◆ for at least 2-4 people to help during the sale.
- ◆ that there will be help after the sale ends.
