Dear Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,

Like many of you I was disturbed by the recent assassination attempt of former President Trump. Regardless of one's feelings or opinions towards Mr. Trump, I find it troubling that someone would desire to end his life in such a violent way. Apparently there are those who find his political views and personality to be so offensive and grating that they believe taking his life is not only the solution but is also justifiable.

This disdain can cause one to be blinded to the reality that he is still a human being who is of value to God. He is loved by his family and a bullet nearly left an empty seat at their Thanksgiving dinner table and a hole in their lives. You may abhor and hate the man, but would you honestly wish this heartache and violent memory upon his family? I am saddened for anyone who might feel this way.

Please recognize *this is <u>not</u> a statement* on my political views nor a statement about how I personally feel about Mr. Trump. However, it is a statement on my Christian views. Hatred can be ugly; hatred can make us ugly and hatred can make us do ugly things.

I was thinking about what Jesus said about murder and I remembered something he said about it. This is what Jesus said in Matthew 5:21-22 according to The Message Translation:

"You're familiar with the command to the ancients, 'Do not murder.' I'm telling you that anyone who is so much as angry with a brother or sister is guilty of murder. Carelessly call a brother 'idiot!' and you just might find yourself hauled into court. Thoughtlessly yell 'stupid!' at a sister and you are on the brink of hellfire. The simple moral fact is that words kill."

It seems to me that Jesus is saying there is more to killing someone's body, a person's soul can also be killed. The reality is that words have power... great power. Words can build up or words can bust up, words can heal or words can hurt, words can do wonders or words can cause wounds. Words can be kind or words can kill.

So my message is very simple: Be careful with your words. Just as bullet can significantly and permanently hurt the life of another person and of those who love that person, so can your words.

"Careless words stab like a sword, but wise words bring healing." Proverbs 12:18

Easy to say, harder to do. But you are responsible for "pulling the trigger" with the intentionally hurtful words you say and the wounds they may cause.
