

#### AN UPDATE ON BABY BARRETT (AKA "BEAR")

The following is "Bears;" Mom's latest update on his brain tumor, 3/24/25:

Barrett has had a great morning! He has had PT, OT, and even a visit from Cece the therapy doggie. He had a little bit of a rough day yesterday with a lot of nausea from the chemo, but praying today is a much better day.

It's DISCHARGE DAY!! We have a few loose ends we need to tie up before we can go, but hopefully those happen soon so we can go be with sissy in the housing.

We have unfortunately entered the portion of this round of chemo where he starts feeling all the side effects. Please continue praying for Barrett as the week goes on. His counts are trending down, so he will probably be neutropenic soon. That means very low white blood cell count and very high risk for infection. Pray for NO infections and for his counts to trend back up quickly! While the chemo is attacking his good cells, we're praying that it's also attacking his nasty tumor/cancer cells. We pray that the tumor is just melting away!
