
Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,


Envelopes are available in the Narthex and back entrance way.

Prayer Request...

AN UPDATE ON BABY BARRETT (AKA "BEAR")

On January 24, we shared with HBC, a prayer request for Baby Barrett for healing prayers due to some very serious health issues.

As time as gone on, this precious little Baby Boy has been thru much, (along with Dad, Mom, Sister and loved ones) with various surgeries and procedures for a brain tumor and is now going through a series of chemo treatments. The following is "Bears;" Mom's latest update, 2/21/25:

"Barret has been doing great! We had a little bump in the road, but he's better now. A few days ago, he started running fevers and feeling crummy all over. They did blood cultures and found he has a strep infection. He's on antibiotics and doing fine so far! Yesterday was a busy day, with speech, OT, and PT. Later today, we will have a visit from a therapy dog. Big sis, Elizabeth will join us for that and is so excited!

<u>PRAYER REQUESTS</u> - <u>Please continue to pray</u> that the chemo is doing its job and completely melting that tumor away, in Jesus' name!

He has one last dose of chemo on Tuesday, Feb. 25 for this round. Please pray that he handles it well. His next round will tentatively start March 10. We are so thankful he won't be getting chemo on his birthday, March 4.

<u>Please continue to pray</u> that the side effects from the chemo will be minimal, and that he is fever free today, and that his vocal cords and swallowing issues continue to heal as well as other nerves damaged by the tumor (*left side facial and hearing*).

We will be doing Version 4 of GriefShare for this 13-week program.
