Dear Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,

For the last couple of weeks Karen and I have been catching up on the show called “The Chosen.” If you have been around the church, you have heard me refer to this show on various occasions.

If you have never heard of The Chosen, let me give you a brief description. It is a show about Jesus and the ‘chosen’ that have been called to follow him. We, the viewers, are offered an opportunity to see Jesus through the eyes, lives and experiences of those who walked with and encountered Jesus.

The writers take some obvious liberties in telling the story and therefore the show is not meant to be understood as a literal retelling of the Bible. Also, it is not intended to be a commentary on the Bible; it is meant to be an adaptation. In some ways I find it helps to bring certain Biblical stories to life.

One of my favorite scenes involves the disciple Matthew as he has a conversation with Gaius, a Roman soldier. Although Matthew is Jewish and Gaius is Roman, the two have formed an unexpected liking and respect for the other.

Matthew is portrayed as having autism; he is socially awkward, he is a bit of a clean freak, he likes things organized and structured, he shares exactly what he is thinking without any filters. The Gospels and history do not confirm that Matthew had autism but, as I said, the show takes some liberties in telling the story.

In one scene Matthew and Gaius encounter one another on the street. In a moment of rare vulnerability Gaius admits to Matthew that his personal life is not going well and he feels helpless.

In response Matthew says “My teacher (Jesus) makes life very simple...Every morning I wake up my ideas and fears are jumbled. I feel overwhelmed with doubt and regret. But if I just pause for a moment and remember that I have only one thing to do today: Follow him. The rest takes care of itself.”

This scene pricks my conscience every time I see it. How often do I forget that I only have one thing to do today... follow him. I can get so overwhelmed in my personal and professional “to-do” lists and the “would’ve, could’ve, should’ve” of my life that I neglect to remember I really have only one thing to do: follow him. And when I do, Matthew is right, the rest seems to take care of itself.

So, this letter is meant for me as much as it is for you. Follow him and the rest will take care of itself.
