Dear Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,

Many, many years ago my grandmother received a disturbing phone call. When she answered the phone the person on the other end claimed to be me. This person (pretending to be me) said to my grandmother “Grandma, I’m in Mexico and I need \$500 to return home.”

It was all a scam and they picked the wrong grandmother to call. My grandmother simply said “My grandson is not in Mexico and you sound nothing like him” and she promptly hung up the phone.

That was a long time ago, but unfortunately the ability to scam innocent people has become even more sophisticated. With the rapid rise of AI (artificial intelligence) it is very easy to manipulate someone’s voice and physical appearance to make it appear it is the person themselves. All the while it is a fake computer-generated representation of the real person.

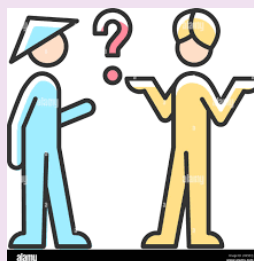
Since our church posts my sermons and our worship services online, it would be very easy for a computer savvy person to recreate my voice and the way I speak. They could then impersonate me using my voice to try and scam people out of money or sensitive information.

***** I share this information to let you know I will never call you, text you or send an email asking for money. If you should receive a phone call, a text message or an email from someone claiming to be me and requesting money or gift cards, it is not me! *****

If this should happen to you hang up the phone immediately and delete any emails without responding to them. If you are suspicious or uncomfortable or something “doesn’t feel right” do not engage any further and certainly do not give out any financial or personal information about yourself.


If you should ever receive any form of communication that purports to be from me or from the church that seems shady, please talk to me directly or call the church office and speak to Dawn. It is better to be safe than sorry and I don’t want any of you to be taken advantage of.

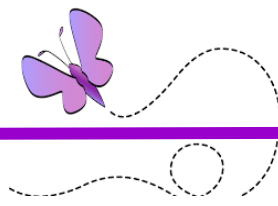

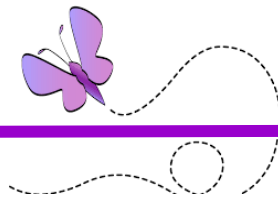

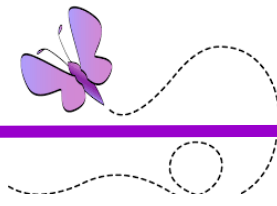
Property News...

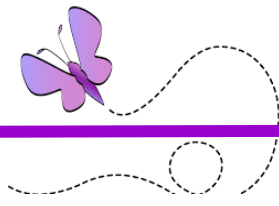


Offering envelopes for the "Blanket Offering" are located in the Back entrance & Narthex. Please remember checks are made out to ***"Hilton Baptist Church"***.

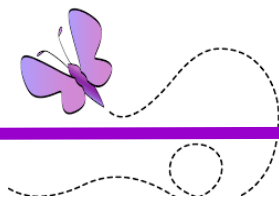

Hilton Baptist Church, 50 Lake Ave., Hilton, NY

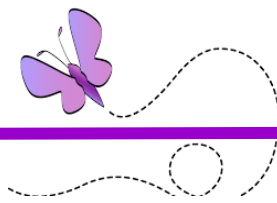


The beautiful quilt measures 55 inches wide by 64 inches long. It features multiple bright colors with animals and animal prints. Makes a great Kids Quilt!

Maryview Dr. is on the left with a white picket fence and a sign Villas at East Hampton. The clubhouse is on the left (111 Maryview) next to the swimming pool. Park in the lot or on the street.

HBC has 5 departments plus many committees and an Official Board that keeps the church running.

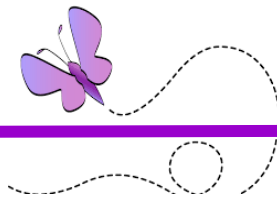
May ends the churches calendar year at which time the church looks for new folks to join our departments and committees.

Who or Why...

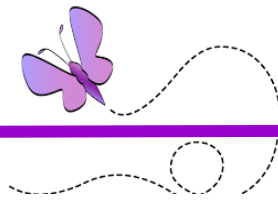

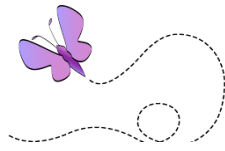
