- Several Meetings

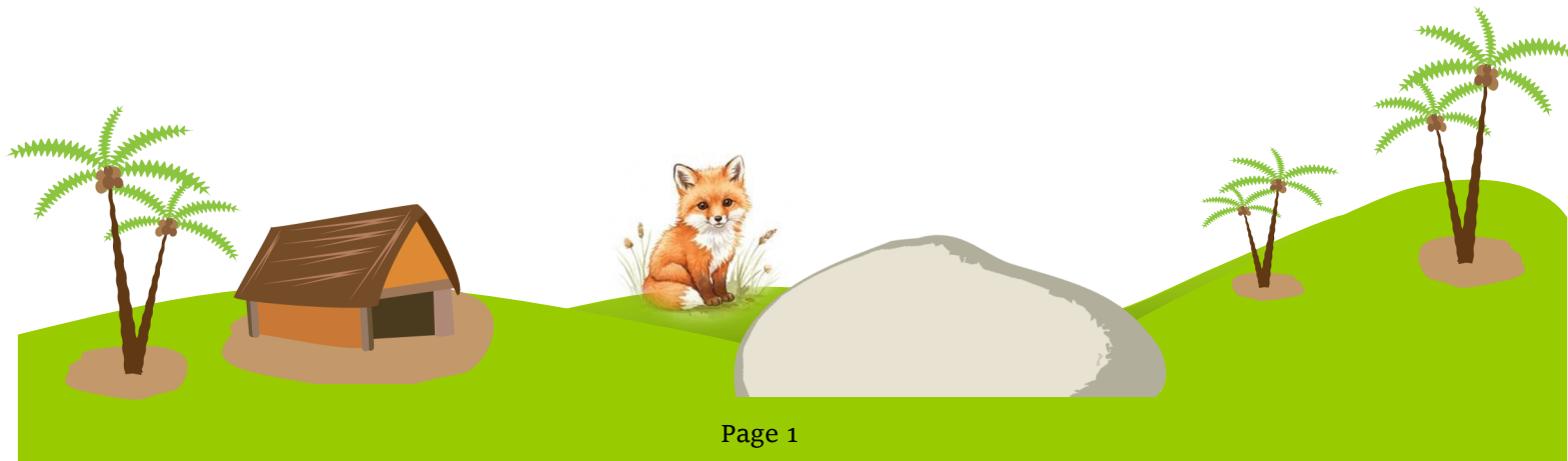
I am going to keep this short and straightforward, by simply saying “Thank you”.

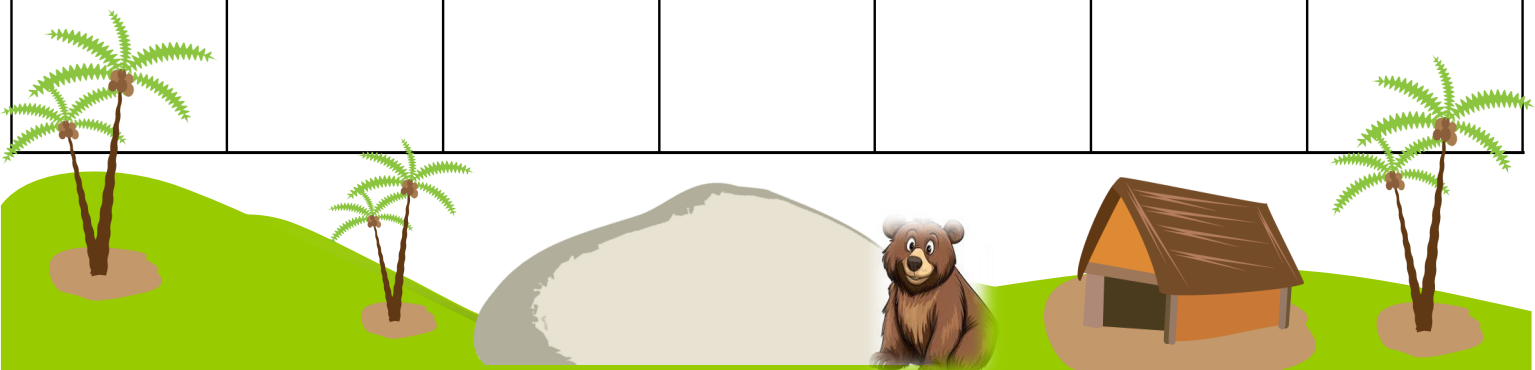

FROM "BEARS" MOM:

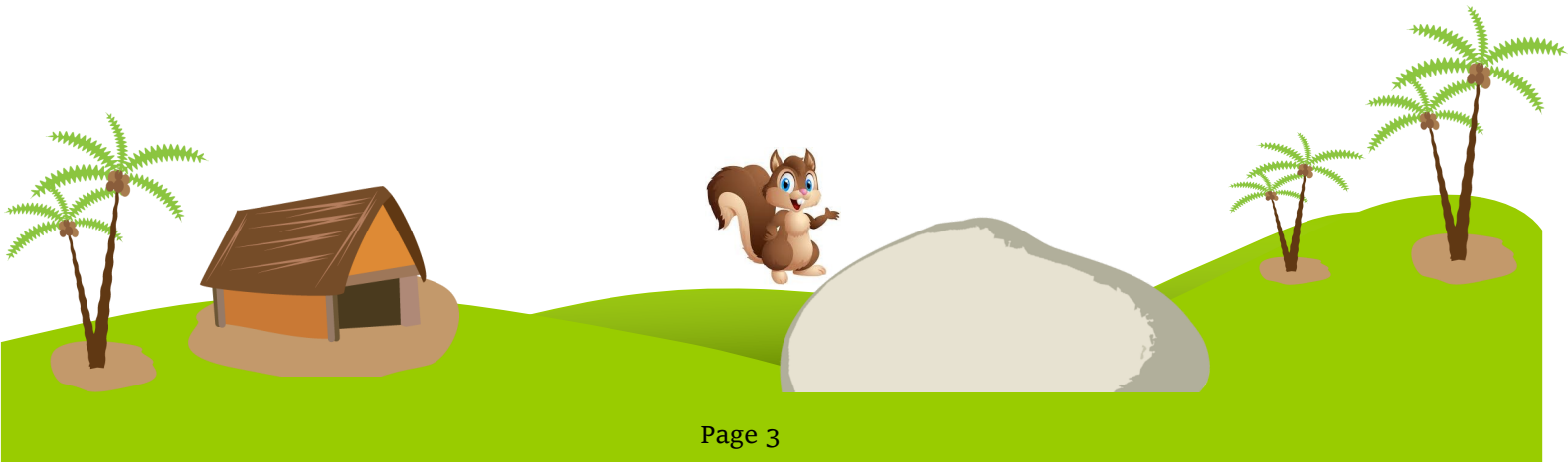
June 18 was National Cancer Survivors Day! A day I pray we get to celebrate with Barrett for the rest of our lives. Bear IS a cancer survivor!

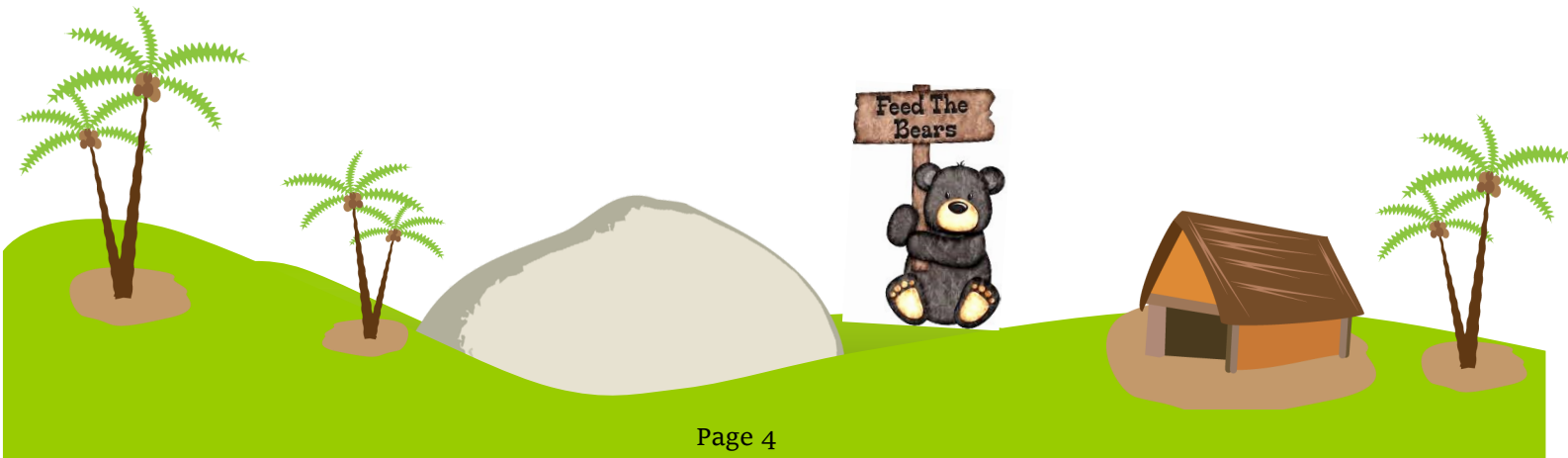

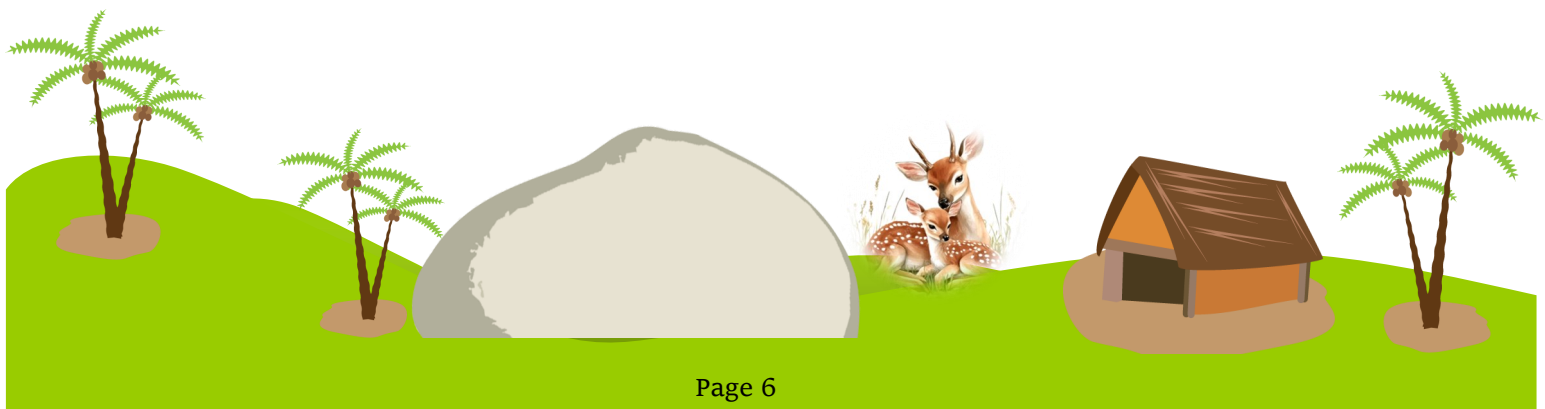

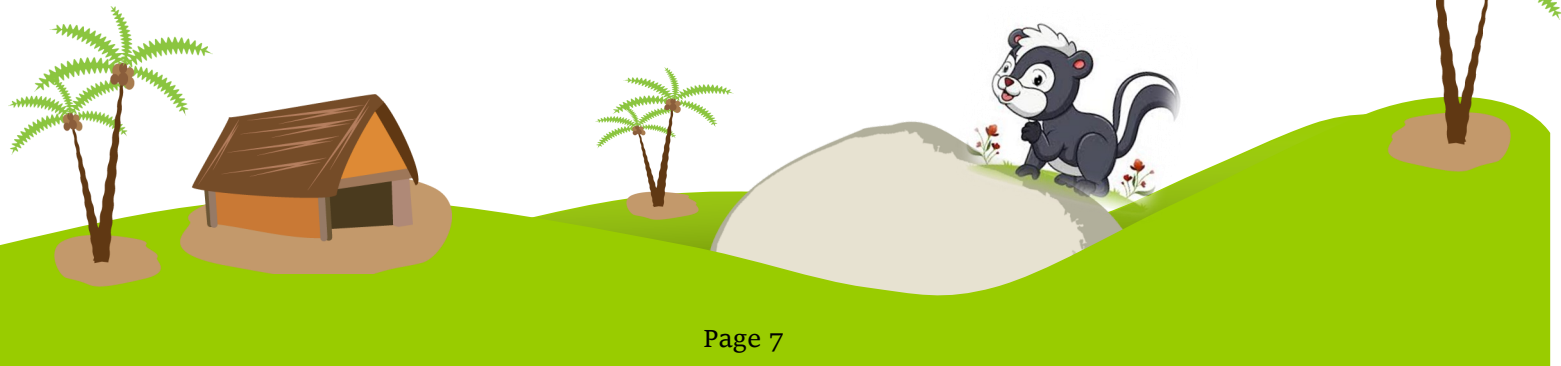
Rummage (and Baked Good) Sale Thank You!

Thanks to all who took part in making it a positive community event.

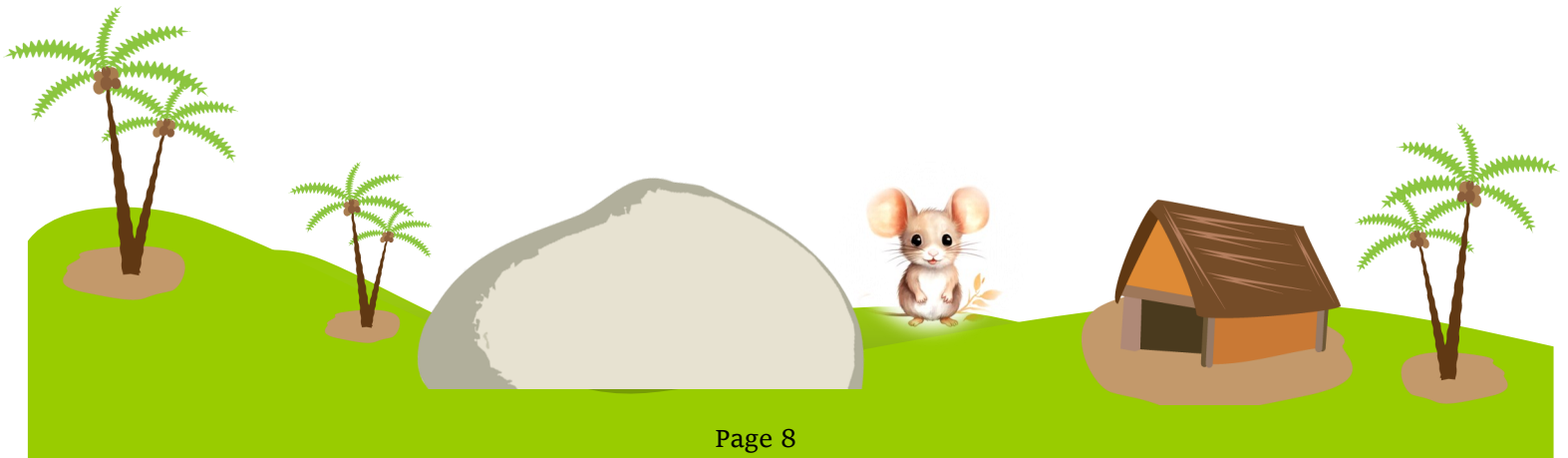

Meeting Time and Place:

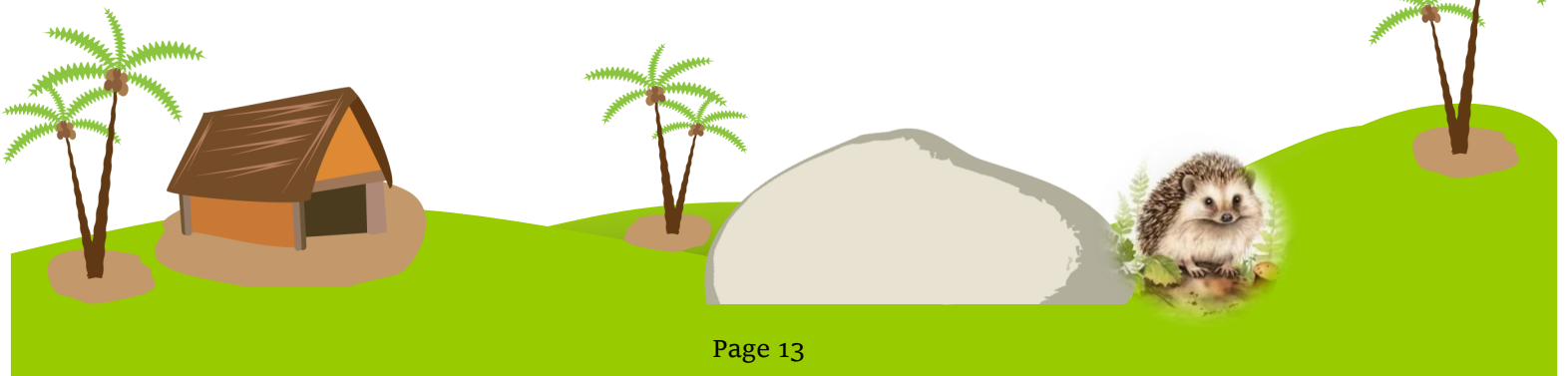
