Dear Friends and Family of Hilton Baptist Church,

One of the best parts of going to a movie is watching the coming attractions before the movie begins. Whoever came up with this idea was a genius because with any luck the previews will generate conversations and build anticipation to see the movie when it is finally released in theatres.

I thought I might take this time to give you a “sneak peek” at what you can expect for the Fall into Advent.

My grandfather used to say “When in doubt, read the instructions.” That is good advice. I admit, sometimes I don’t have the patience or the desire to read the instructions. I tell myself “This looks pretty easy and I’m a smart guy. I can figure this out on my own”, until I can’t.

Frustrated I say “This part isn’t fitting where it looks like it should fit and what on earth is this thing?” It is then that Grandpa’s words come back into my mind - “When in doubt, read the instructions.” This Fall, that is exactly what we are going to do.

We will spend several weeks on Sunday mornings in the Old Testament book of Proverbs. This is a book of wise sayings and sage advice. While we won’t look at every single proverb, we will touch upon a few. May I make a suggestion in preparation for our time in the Proverbs?

I believe it was Billy Graham who read one chapter of the Proverbs every day. Since most months have thirty-one days, a person can read through all the proverbs in a month. Perhaps you may consider taking the month of September to read a Proverb a day? (Be aware, you will need to double up on one day since September only has thirty days□).

After we spend some time with the Proverbs, we will take a few weeks to remember the people who came before us, those who will come after us and those who are with us. Before we know it, the season of Advent will be upon us.

Many of you enjoyed the forest we built in the sanctuary last year and asked that we re-create it again this year. During the Advent season, we will venture into the woods again and encounter new teachers from nature who will give us insight into the coming of the Christ child.

One more thing, on Sunday September 13 we will be trying something new. Every year we have a “work day” at the church to spruce up the building or finish some projects. Unfortunately, very few folks come out for the work day.

On September 13, we are inviting everyone to bring some work clothes and after the service, we will have a work day. This is a chance for us to care for the building which has cared for us, be in community together and help out in any way we can. More on this will come later but I hope you will participate!

Spread the word, come to church and let’s keep God’s work going! Be Still, Dan

BARRETT "BEAR" BARNES UPDATE...



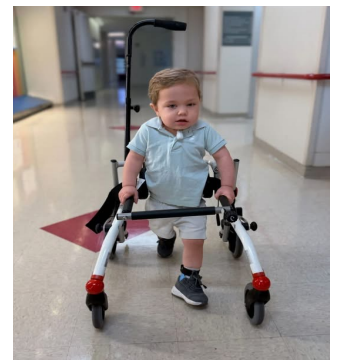
August 20th was scan week and we were hoping for another victory that Barrett is still cancer free. We were praying and believing that we would see "no evidence of disease" written in the MRI report!

The Hilton Applefest is October 3 & 4 and Hilton Baptist Church will be participating with 2 booths and **we need your help!**

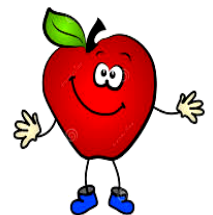
This is a great way for HBC to be seen as part of our community. It takes **lots of volunteers** to run these booths.

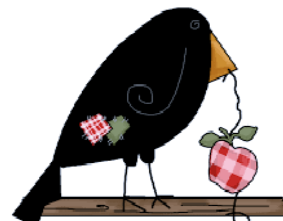

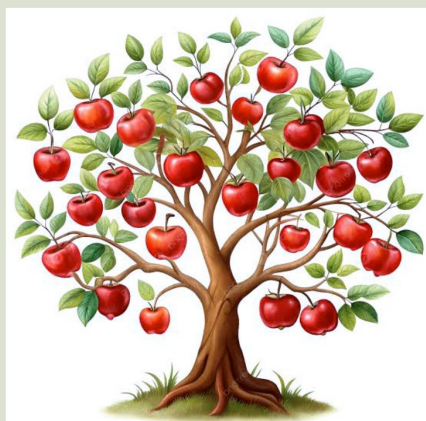

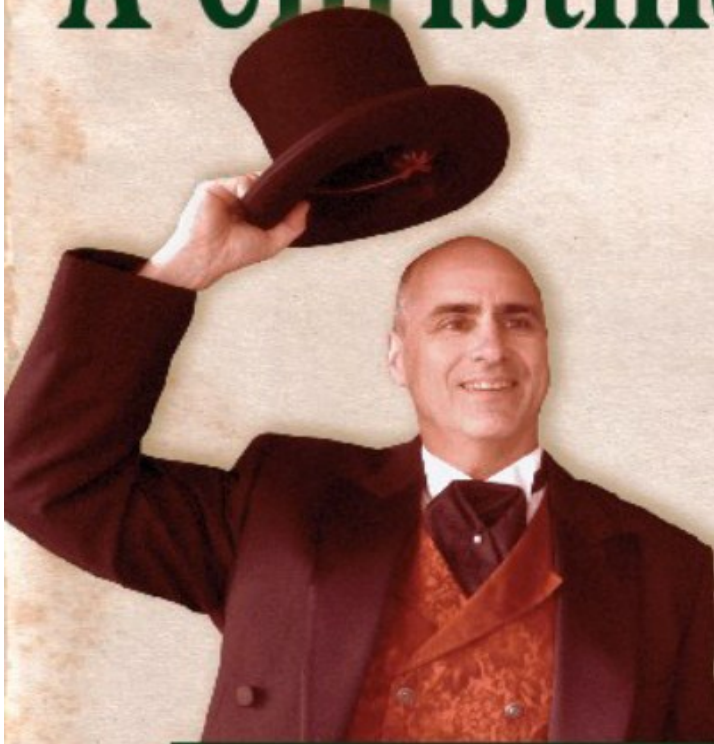
